OPTIONAL EXTENSION TO PETRA IN JORDAN

Join us for a once in a lifetime experience as we travel to the land of Christ's birth and meet the complex mix of people who dwell in that land today!

Offered by the Israel/Palestine Mission Network of the PC (USA), this Presbyterian pilgrimage will spend time in the major holy sites of Bethlehem, Nazareth, the Galilee, and Jerusalem. We will meet Israelis and Palestinians, Jews, Muslims and Christians, as we learn about a complex conflict through their eyes. We will also spend time in a rural area in the Northern West Bank, a major source

of Palestinian olive oil, where we will lend a hand in the olive harvest (if the timing is right) and take part in a regional festival celebrating the harvest.

Special to this trip will be time spent with Palestinian Christians and other long-term partners of the Presbyterian Church (USA). Our hope is that pilgrims will establish on-going relationships with one or more of those PC (USA) partners. In order to sustain these partnerships, we are planning this pilgrimage to include people from a few locations in the U.S., preferably coming from more than one congre-

gation in a Presbytery or adjacent Presbyteries. The trip will be co-led by three experienced Presbyterians: Marthame Sanders, a pastor who spent three and a half years as Presbyterian missionary; and Peter Mann and Donald Mead, both Presbyterian Elders who have spent time in the Middle East. Peter is the founder and president of Import Peace, a fair trade olive oil partnership. Don is a retired economist whose introduction to the region came through work with Palestinian refugees in Cairo, in the late 1950s.

DAY-BY-DAY ITINERARY

SUN 31 OCT Depart USA

Depart Atlanta on the non-stop, overnight flight to Israel via Delta Airlines. (Meals in-flight)

MON 01 NOV Arrive Tel Aviv/Bethlehem

Arrive at Tel Aviv's Ben Gurion Airport at 4:20PM - your guide and driver will be waiting to transfer you to Bethlehem. After hotel check-in enjoy some time to relax and freshen up before joining the group for dinner this evening at ICB's Il'ilyeh Restaurant. (Meals in-flight, D)

TUE 02 NOV Bethlehem

This morning meet at the International Center of Bethlehem (ICB) for an introduction to the staff and their work as part of the Diyar Consortium. The Lutheran based, ecumenically oriented institutions of this consortium serve the whole Palestinian community from "the womb to the tomb," with an emphasis on children, youth, women and the elderly through unique programs that are contextual and holistic in nature. Take a walking tour of the Old City visiting the Church of the Nativity and Manager Square. This afternoon visit Shepherds Fields in Beit Sahour. Dinner at ICB's Il'ilyeh Restaurant. (B, D)

WED 03 NOV Bethlehem /Galilee

This morning meet with representatives of the Applied Research Institute of Jerusalem at their Bethlehem office. Then meet during lunch with a local speaker regarding Israeli/Palestinian reconciliation. Tour an Israeli settlement with a resident and visit Deheishe Refugee Camp. Late this afternoon, travel to the Galilee for hotel check-in and dinner. (B, L, D)

THU 04 NOV Galilee

Today tour the Galilee region. See the Ancient Synagogue and St. Peter's House at Capernaum. Drive along the shore to Tabgha for visits to the Church of Multiplication, built on the site of the Miracle of the Loaves and Fishes; and the Chapel of the Primacy of Peter. Visit the Church of the Beatitudes, one of the most beautiful in the Galilee. End the day with a boat ride on the peaceful waters of the Sea of Galilee. Stop at Mt. Arbel for a lovely panoramic view. (B, D)

FRI 05 NOV Galilee/Zababdeh

This morning transfer from the Galilee to Zababdeh. Begin activities planned by our local hosts including attendance at this evening's Olive Harvest Festival. Haddad Hotel (B,D)

SAT 06 NOV Zababdeh

Enjoy another full day of local activities including olive picking. Haddad Hotel (B,D)

SUN 07 NOV Zababdeh/Nazareth

Join morning worship in Zababdeh then say farewell to newfound friends. Travel to Nazareth to visit the Church of the Annunciation, the Greek Orthodox Church and Mary's Well. Nazareth is located between the open space of the Jezreel valley and the mountainous regions of the Galilee. During the first 20 years of his life spent in Nazareth, Jesus had many an opportunity to walk on the mountain ranges, to look over and think about the history of his people. Overnight in Nazareth. (B,D)

MON 08 NOV Nazareth/Jerusalem

Visit Nazareth Village where first century Biblical life is recreated. Then Drive to Ibilin to meet with Elias Chacour, Archbishop of Galilee of the Melkite Greek Catholic Church and author of *Blood Brothers* and *We Belong to the Land* (subject to his availability). Archbishop Chacour will share his journey of peacemaking, including the establishment of Mar Elias Educational Institutions, whose motto is "building peace through education." Continue to Jerusalem for hotel check-in and overnight. (B,D)

TUE 09 NOV Jerusalem

Begin the day atop the Mount of Olives with its stunning panoramic view of Jerusalem. Then walk in Jesus' footsteps down the Palm Sunday Road to arrive at the Garden of Gethsemane. Cross the Kidron Valley and visit the ancient City of David excavations. Continue to Mt. Zion for a visit to St. Peter's in Gallicantu, which commemorates Peter's three denials of Christ and Caiaphas' House where Jesus was imprisoned. This afternoon learn about the work of the Israeli Committee Against House Demolition (ICAHD) and view the controversial Separation Wall. (B,D)

WED 10 NOV Jerusalem

Start the day at the Temple Mount (Haram al Sharif in Arabic) with the Al Aqsa Mosque, sacred for the Muslims, second only to Mecca; continue to the Western Wall, the holiest site for Jews; then walk the Stations of the Cross along the Via Dolorosa ending at the Church of Holy Sepulchre. En route stop at the Church of the Sisters of Zion (Ecce Homo) to see the original street level pavement from the time of Jesus. During the course of the day meet with representatives of B'Tselem, the Israeli policy human rights organization, for a meeting with one of their representatives. (B,D)

THU 11 NOV Jerusalem

Check out of the hotel this morning - two day rooms will be kept until departure to the airport this evening (Travelers going to Petra will stay overnight at the hotel). This morning meet with Ophir Yarden of the Inter-Religious Coordinating Council in Israel, then get new perspectives on a close up visit to the Separation Wall. This afternoon explore the Old City on your own. Gather for a farewell dinner before an evening transfer to the airport for flight check in and departure at 11:50PM on the non-stop flight to Atlanta. (B,D)

FRI 12 NOV Return to USA

Arrive in Atlanta at 6:05 AM where travelers can connect with continuing flights. Return home the same day enriched with a new understanding of the ancient and contemporary world of the Holy Land. (Meals in-flight)

Petra, Jordan Option Extension

FRI 12 NOV Jerusalem/Petra

This morning transfer to the Israel/Jordan border crossing at the Allenby Bridge. Meet your Jordanian guide and coach. Then drive to Mount Nebo from where Moses viewed the Promised Land. Standing atop the hill you overlook the Jordan Valley, Jericho and the Judean hills beyond. Nearby visit the Christian village of Madaba to see the ancient mosaic map of the Holy Land. Now travel southward, cross-country through the desert to the village of Wadi Musa, which nestles around Petra. Check in at your hotel for dinner and overnight. (B, D)

SAT 13 NOV

Petra/Amman

This morning tour Petra, the rose-red city carved out of the mountains, which was lost for 1000 years. As you draw near Petra you have the choice of walking or taking a carriage through the dramatic "ciq" or canyon (cost of the carriage ride is not included). From the 3rd century B.C. to the 2nd century A.D., the Nabateans made Sela Edom (red rock city) their capital and carved buildings befitting their status along an important trade route. Visit the most interesting carved monuments such as the elegant Treasury (Al Khazneh), the field of tombs, and the colonnaded street. See the Crusaders' Castle Shawbak, which was built to protect the eastern flank of the Latin Kingdom and its trade routes to the Red Sea and then travel to Amman. Join the group for a final dinner before flight check-in and departure at 11:55PM this evening. (B, D)

SUN 14 NOV

Return to U.S.

Arrive at JFK Airport 5:30AM this morning where travelers can connect with continuing flights. Arrive home this same day enriched with a new understanding of the ancient and contemporary world of the Holy Land. (Meals in-flight)
